We have a history of listening to the needs of our community and responding.




Through our programs, we provide:

Skip-a-Long Childhood Centers

Nationally accredited and highly rated early care and education centers serving children ages six weeks through 12 years with a mission to make sure every child is prepared for success in school and in life.

Home Child Care Network

Free consultation and support for licensed home child care providers in Illinois to ensure high-quality care.

Early Head Start Child Care Partnerships

Comprehensive, individualized services for low-income families including pregnant mothers, infants, and toddlers up to age four.

Prevention Initiative

Intensive, research-based child development and family support services for families with children from birth to age three, with an aim of building a strong early learning foundation and preparing children for later school success.

Help for parents finding licensed child care options and assistance for families applying for help to pay for care, as well as support for child care providers, including training, professional development, resources, grant funding, and more.


Stabilization Services
